Devon Midori Hale is a public artist and muralist with a community-based practice. As a mixed-race Asian American third generation resident of Seattle, she earned her BFA in Painting at University of Washington in 2009. Hale has a broad range of professional experience in art, ranging from stop-motion animator to art curation to teaching artist in a variety of settings, such as with incarcerated women, youth and elders of Yesler Terrace (a historic subsidized public housing in Seattle), elders in assisted living, adults recovering from homelessness, family programming at the Henry Art Gallery, and more. Most recently, she has worked with a colleague from UW to create integrated arts-based math curriculum (Math Through Murals), exhibited the inaugural public artwork at the new Pier 62 Park on Seattle's waterfront.
